KS1 Activity plan – Create a storyboard

5mins Safer Internet Assembly

Show children the Safer Internet Day live or recorded assembly which provides context for the competition. You can access both the live and recorded assembly here:

10mins Characterisation

Explain to pupils that they will be creating a cartoon / storyboard to illustrate a short story about how to stay safe when gaming online.

Ideally, the storyboard will have up to three characters involved. Ensure that pupils understand that these don't need to be humans, they could be robots, cats, unicorns – whatever they like. It's important to let their imagination loose. They might want to think about their characteristics such as:

- What do they like to do?
- What are they scared of?
- What quirks or actions do they have?

10mins Planning

Ask pupils to note down the sequence of events for their story. They may end up with more than 8 and they should then think about removing some events/scenes so they have a maximum of 8 different scenes.

30mins Get making

Now pupils can get artistic and design their 8 scenes. Remind them to use a maximum of two different backgrounds (if they are using backgrounds). They may wish to include:

- Speech bubbles to show the narrative of the story
- Annotations to support their drawings if anything needs clarification
- Colour to make the storyboard stand out with extra aesthetics

5mins Safer Internet Assembly

5mins Stay Safe

Ask pupils to discuss or share in the chat window different approaches they have seen to help children stay safe online. This could include:

- **Keyboard that records key presses**
- **Reporting buttons on social media sites**
- **Software that removes inappropriate language in online games**
- **User reporting in online games**
- **Questions asked by games or social media sites to prove ages of users**
- **Family locks that stop children downloading or view content that isn't age appropriate**

10mins New Technologies

Ask pupils to search for new technologies online. This may help them think about how future technologies could be used in innovative ways to help keep children safe online. Here is a selection of websites that may be useful:

The aim of this is to open their minds to what is possible and to ensure that they think about what may be possible, not what is currently possible.

5mins Grabbing Attention

Start a discussion with pupils to find out what grabs their attention and why. Is it artwork? Is it lyrics from a song or rap? Is it a short story that allows them to create their own vision of what might be happening?

Ask pupils to use the template provided to demonstrate their idea of how technology could keep children safe online. They should use the template to create one of the following:

- **A poem**

- A poster
- An annotated illustration
- A short story
- Lyrics to a song or a rap

30mins **Get Making**

Pupils produce their idea or design in the space provided on the template. After 15mins pupils could share what they have produced so far to gather feedback and then complete their work.

Reminding pupils to write their first name onto the template along with their age.
